2018 UNITED METHODIST MEN'S SCHOLARSHIP

The United Methodist Men will offer scholarships of \$1500 to 2 graduating seniors (class of 2018) who are members of First United Methodist Church and who plan to enroll in an institution of higher learning in the Fall of 2018.

In order to be eligible for this scholarship you must:

1. enter a college, university, or community college in the Fall of 2018.
2. become a full-time student.
3. be a member of First United Methodist Church of Salem, Virginia.
4. submit all completed application forms, including the "School Administrative Supporting Form", by the deadline of Sunday, May 20, 2018..
5. Provide a letter of recommendation from an adult member of First United Methodist Church (not a parent or Jessica Kaufman).

Students who apply for this scholarship may accept other grants and/or scholarships.

10. What academic or co-curricular awards, recognitions, honors, and achievements have you received?

11. What community-related service activities have you participated in during the last 4 years?

12. What part-time or full-time paid work have you done?

13. Do you have any brothers or sisters living at home or attending college? If so, please list them.

14. Since this scholarship is awarded partly based on financial need, please report the total dollar amount on which your parents paid taxes this year. (This is the net dollar amount after all deductions are subtracted from income, and the amount that determines the income tax paid.)

15. Explain how you plan to cover your college expenses (i.e loans, parents, money earned, scholarships, loans, etc.)

16. List all scholarships and grants that you have received that will assist with college expenses, including approximate amounts.

17. On a separate page, submit a one-page essay that tells the Committee about you, and why you feel you should be considered for this scholarship.

18. Ask an adult member of First United Methodist Church to submit a letter of recommendation on your behalf. This person should NOT be a parent or Jessica Kaufman, who is a member of the Scholarship Committee. This letter should be sent to:
