LITTLE LAMBS | 12-23 MONTHS

Our mornings are busy and fun! These little ones and their two teachers spend their morning singing songs, reading stories, doing creative activities, and going out to their own playground!

GREEN BUNNIES & YELLOW BUNNIES | 2 YEAR OLDS

A typical day in the two-year-old classrooms will find the children involved in small group activities (art, crafts, & learning games), music and movement, story time, learning centers, and outdoor play. Our teachers share God's love with the children through Bible stories, scripture memorization, and songs. Our teachers understand that your child might not be potty trained when they start this class. They will work with your child on this when you are ready to begin this process.

RED BEARS, YELLOW BEARS & GREEN BEARS | 3 YEAR OLDS

The three-year-old classrooms are active places filled with learning activities and creativity! Their lesson plans include arts and crafts, literacy activities, creative play, story time, music class and outdoor play. The three-year-old children attend Chapel once a week and learn about God's love for them.

RED, BLUE, GREEN AND YELLOW BIRDS | 4 YEAR OLDS

Our four-year-old class's curriculum is based on the Virginia Foundation Blocks of Early Learning. These are from the Virginia Dept. of Education and provide a measurable range of skills and knowledge essential for four-year-olds to be successful in kindergarten. Our mornings include group learning times, small group activities, story time, learning centers, and outdoor active play. Each week the children attend a special music class and chapel where they are learning about the Bible and God's love for them. Each month the children go on a field trip to enhance what they have learned in their classroom. All classes are taught in a developmentally appropriate way, so the children know that learning is fun!
